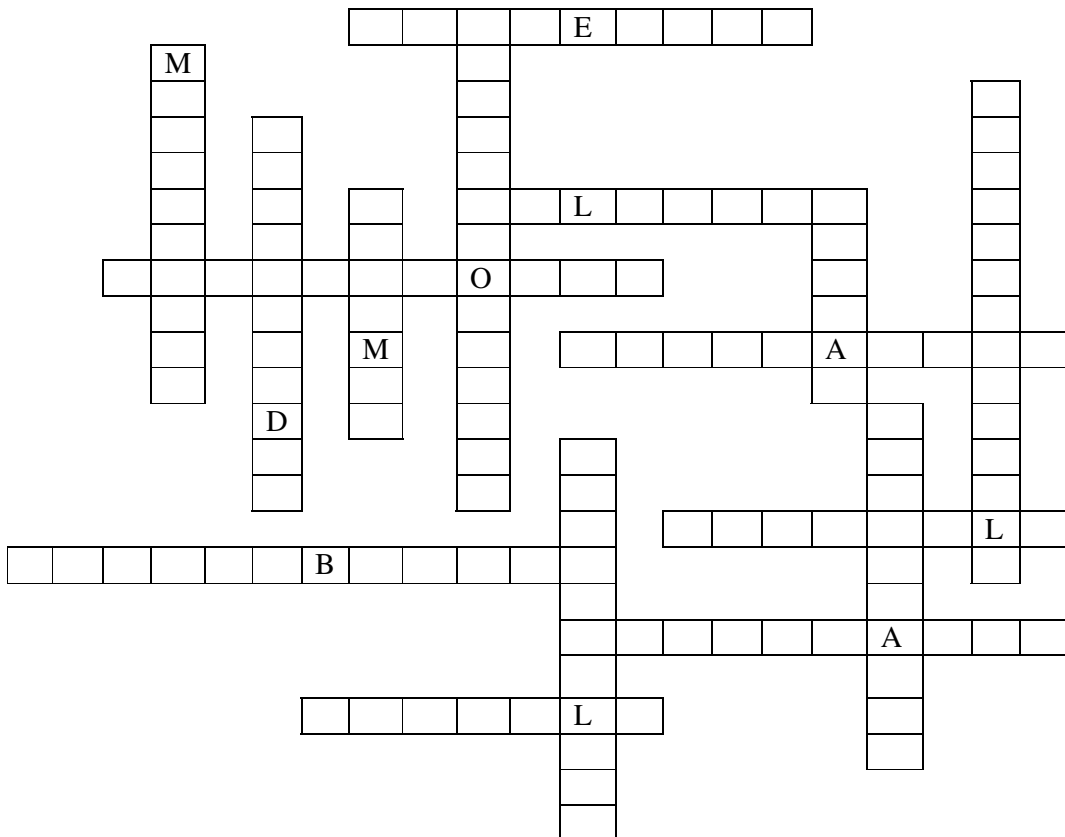


## River Dance
