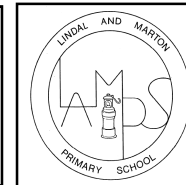

### InsideOut Soccer

#### After-school Football Coaching

For the next two terms football coaching will be provided by InsideOut Soccer. There will be ten weekly sessions before Christmas and ten in the Spring term. The sessions will be held on a Monday after school in blocks of five weeks. The first five weeks will be for the pupils in Years 5 & 6 starting on the 20th September. The coaches can only supervise groups of 16 children so we will be taking interested names on a first come first served basis. The second block of five weeks will start on the 1st November for pupils from Years 3 & 4. Last year's coaching was funded through a grant, however as funding is not available for this year, we are asking parents to pay £1 per session towards the cost of the coaches.

### Afterschool Clubs

After school clubs will start again this half term.

- Junior Gymnastics club will start on Tuesday 21st September. (3.15-4pm)
- Year 1 & 2 Gymnastics club will start on Thursday 23rd September. (3.15- 4pm)

The last week for all after school clubs will be the week commencing 22nd November. After this date the hall will be used to prepare for the Christmas production.

Details regarding the start date of Art Club will follow soon.

### Parents Evening

All classes will be having a Parents Evening this term on either Monday 8th or Tuesday 9th November from 3.30-6pm. This will be an opportunity for you to find out how your child has settled this term, see your child's current targets and to ask any questions you may have. A letter will be sent out nearer the time asking you to suggest your preferred date and time and we will try our best to accommodate all your requests.

### School Council News

The School Council worked hard last year to raise extra money towards the residential. The coin collection and cake sales together raised £284. Thank you for your help and contributions of coins and cakes.

As a thank you to the children in Class 1 & 2, the School Council will use some of the money raised to buy something for the younger children's classrooms.

On Friday 24th September it is European Languages Day and the children will be able to come dressed in the colours of a European Flag, for a £1 fee. The money raised will be donated to the Mountain Rescue Service.

Each day children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are provided with a piece of fruit or a vegetable for their mid-morning snack. In addition to the typical seasonal range of fruit and vegetables (apples, bananas, pears, clementines, carrots and tomatoes) strawberries and cucumbers are occasionally supplied. Please advise us if your child may be allergic to any of these.
